Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

On March 29 and 30, Tomaszów Lubelski and Pawłówka hosted a commemorative event focused on the burial site of three Jewish children: Rywka, Balka and Jankiel, murdered by and buried near their home in Pawłówka during the Holocaust. It was one event spread over two subsequent days.

Start on the 29th of March, 2023

Educational activities at the high school in Tomaszów Lubelski:

It is an element of our methodology to always precede a commemorative event with an educational component. In this case it was a screening of the documentary "Bevel of Light" directed by Wojciech Szumowski in a local school. The protagonist of the film is Dariusz Popiela - a Polish whitewater canoeist, four-time World Championships medalist, two-time European champion, who restores the memory of neglected Jewish cemeteries in Podhale. After the screening, there was a conversation with representatives of the Zapomniane Foundation: Agnieszka Nieradko-Pająk and Aleksander Schwarz about the film and about the work on restoring the memory of the forgotten burial places of Holocaust victims and the history of the forgotten burial place of three children from Pawłówka. The meeting also consisted of a Q&A with the youth. The meeting ended with vocal and musical performances prepared by young people. The meeting was attended by 66 people, including: high school students, headmaster, teachers, representatives of the starosty and commune, representatives of the Regional Museum and the Bełżec Museum, as well as local activists.

Continuation on the 30th of March, 2023 Pawłówka

As part of the project co-financed by the Association of the Jewish Historical Institute, we conducted workshops in Pawłówka. During the workshop, together with students of one class of a high school from Tomaszów Lubelski and one class of a primary school from Michalów, we prepared a wooden marker in the form of a matzeva, and then - using a portable laser - we burned an inscription on it, along with the names of children written by the hands of workshop participants.

After the workshop, together with the young people, we went on a walk to the burial place of three children, where a commemorative ceremony of marking the place with a wooden matzeva took place.

Apart from young people, the ceremony was attended by representatives of local authorities (2 people), employees of the regional museum and the museum in Bełżec (heritage professionals and academics - 3 people), teachers and educators (7 people), representatives of loca civil society organizations and several residents along with the local choir.
